



Display Spa Pre-permitting Checklist-Operator

- Disinfectant concentrations maintained at or above 3 ppm free chlorine or 4 ppm free bromine
- pH maintained between 7.0-7.8
- Written water quality records to include disinfectant concentration*, pH, and the type and amount of chemicals added to the display spa (must be kept on site during the event and for 6 months after the completion of the event). **disinfectant residual shall be measured every day before opening the display spa to the public and every four hours thereafter until the display spa is closed for the day*
- A sign posted on each permitted display spa that states, in at least 2 inch letter height: "DISPLAY SPA – ONLY HANDS AND FOREARMS ALLOWED IN WATER."
- A sign available that states, in at least 2 inch letter height: "SPA CLOSED."
- All pool chemicals stored on-site stored in a water resistant, covered container in an area that is not used by the public.
- Latching or locking cover available for spa when the applicant or applicant's designee is not available to supervise the display spa or the spa is closed for the day
