MOVING LOCATION OF BUNCOMBE COUNTY PRECINCT #44

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes 163-128 provides that the County Board of Elections shall have the power from time to time to establish, alter, discontinue, or create such new election precincts or voting places as it may deem expedient.

- 1. That pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 163-128, voting for Precinct #44 will cease to occur New Morgan Hill Baptist Church; and,
- 2. That pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 163-128, Heaven's Cloud Event Center, 130 Sardis Road, Asheville, North Carolina will be the new voting location for Precinct #44; and,
- 3. That all notice requirements of North Carolina General Statutes 163 be met.
