Narrative summary of grant related activities

The permitting requirements to install a washer and dryer in our space in the Asheville Mall rendered our original proposal impractical, so in August we pivoted our focus to include improvements in our art education/art therapy program, our indoor gardening program, our sensory room and updating our space in the mall.

For the art education/therapy program, we purchased and installed a storage cabinet for art supplies and a kiln for making ceramics and jewelry. We also bought other supplies needed for the program. The program continues to be very popular and beneficial to our clients.

The indoor gardening room has gotten some new grow lights, a workbench, some hand gardening tools, a circulation fan and some new plant hangers in the room.

We have added a hanging egg chair, bean bag chairs, a star projector and a bubble lamp to the sensory room, making it a much more inviting and calming scene. It continues to be a destination for clients who want a place to chill out.

Under the category of updating our mall space, we have installed a storage cube cabinet in the big room to better organize the fitness equipment, installed floor tiles in the kitchen area, added an area rug, and purchased sheets and other linens for therapies such as massage.
