| Buncombe County has received a \$3,000.00 grant in mitigation funds to retrofit the 911 center to protect against non-structural earthquake damage. Buncombe County is classified as being at moderate risk of earthquake. Statistics show that 70% of earthquake damage is non-structural (i.e. building contents). There is a significant amount of electronic equipment in the 911 center that can be anchored and/or braced to mitigate the potential for such damage. |
