Background information

The proposed amendment language was generated in response to SL2013-126, which set forth revised standards for public hearing procedures. In addition, other administrative changes relating to public hearing proceedings were included to provide further clarification and promote greater efficiency. For specific language in the Land Use Plan update, please refer to Section 7 of the 2013 Update, or the statement of consistency located on pages one and two of the Planning Board's January 6th resolution. The Planning Board recommended approval of the language at their January 6, 2014 meeting in a vote of 6 to 0.

Pros

- These changes are procedural and bring the County's Zoning Ordinance in line with recent changes to the North Carolina General Statutes.
- By allowing the Zoning Administrator to also bring forward amendments to the Zoning Ordinance the review process required for zoning amendments can be expedited where necessary.
- Clarification of the language regarding the variance process will help guide applicants and concerned citizens to provide more relevant evidence to the Board of Adjustment regarding specific variance cases.
