# **Background information**

The proposed amendments were generated in response to recommendations made within the 2013 Comprehensive Land Use Plan Update. For specific language in the Land Use Plan update, please refer to Section 6 of the 2013 Update, or the statement of consistency located on pages one and two of the Planning Board's January 27<sup>th</sup> resolution. The Planning Board recommended approval of the language at their January 27, 2014 meeting in a vote of 8 to 0.

#### **Pros**

- These changes will align lot size and setback requirements to the surrounding land use context and the availability of infrastructure
- These changes promote a connection between the density of development and the availability of public utilities, which may serve to increase access to housing in areas of high opportunity and decrease development pressures in more rural areas
- See Planning Board Resolution recommending approval
