RESOLUTION DONATING SURPLUS LIVE SCAN 210 X-RAY MACHINE TO MADISON COUNTY

- WHEREAS, a request has been received from Madison County for the donation of surplus, live scan X-Ray machine equipment for use by the Madison County Sheriff; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. 153A-176 and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-280, the County may transfer to another governmental unit equipment that the governing board determines to be surplus, obsolete or unused; and
- WHEREAS, Madison County is a governmental unit in accordance with Article 12, Ch. 160A of North Carolina General Statutes; and
- WHEREAS, the County has a surplus live scan x-ray machine (Modal 210E, Serial #56627) and the Buncombe County Detention Center Director and County Sheriff as well as the Purchasing Agent recommend that said equipment be donated to Madison County; and
- WHEREAS, this Board believes the donation of the surplus equipment will aid Madison County in their work for the community; and
- WHEREAS, public notice of the Commissioner's intent to transfer said personal property to Madison County has been made at least five (5) days prior to the adoption of this resolution; and
- WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the County that this resolution be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That a surplus live scan x-ray machine (Modal 210E, Serial #56627) identified by the County Detention Center Director and Purchasing Agent be declared surplus property.
2. That the donation of said equipment to Madison County be and is hereby approved and accepted.
3. This resolution be effective upon adoption.
