RESOLUTION REACTIVATING THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY WOMEN'S COMMISSION

- WHEREAS, the Buncombe County Women's Involvement Council was created and established by Resolution #17874 on April 17, 1984 and renamed the Women's Commission in 1999; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Commission accomplished its original goals as outlined in Resolution #17874 and has been inactive for several years; and
- **WHEREAS**, this Board feels that it is time to reactivate the Women's Commission asking that it advise on key issues involving the social and economic conditions of women.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That this Board does hereby reactivate the Women's Commission to consist of not less than six members and charge the Commission with the following purpose:

To advise the Board of Commissioners on key issues relating to social and economic conditions of women in Buncombe County; educate the community regarding these issues; and advocate for policies that would improve the lives of women in Buncombe County.

2. That the objective of the Women's Commission be:

To develop a biennial work plan which is responsive to current community needs and forward thinking on trending issues; identify and prioritize key focus areas; determine strategic approaches to address these areas; and exercise leadership on their implementation *(including, but not limited to, developing information systems, conducting research, hosting educational programming and convening community outreach)*

- 3. This Commission shall provide regular updates to the Board of Commissioners.
- 4. That this resolution be effective upon its adoption.
