## RESOLUTION ADDRESSING THE IMPORTANCE OF SALES TAX REVENUES

WHEREAS,	Buncombe County depends on sales tax revenues to meet its budget requirements; and	
WHEREAS,	the County receives one percent sales tax revenue under Article 39 of which one half is used to fund K-12 capital needs; and	
WHEREAS,	the County receives one half percent sales tax revenue under Article 40 of which 30 percent is used for K-12 capital repairs and equipment; and	
WHEREAS,	the County receives one half percent sales tax revenue under Article 42 of which 60 percent issued for K-12 capital repairs and equipment; and	
WHEREAS,	more than eleven percent of the County's general fund revenues come from sales tax.	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

- 1. That this Board strongly opposes any state legislation that negatively impacts the current and projected amount of total sales tax collected by Buncombe County.
- 2. That this resolution be effective upon its adoption
