- WHEREAS, funding for lung cancer research trails far behind other cancers; and
- WHEREAS; Buncombe County has demonstrated its commitment by endorsing the community health Tobacco Cessation and Prevention Plan designed to decrease smoking and exposure to second hand smoke in our community and by making all County properties smoke-free zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That the month of November be proclaimed

in Buncombe County

- 2. That all our citizens be urged to learn more about lung cancer prevention and join the effort to defeat lung cancer.
