#### Description of Project

ABCCM requests \$350,000 to help construct ABCCM's Veterans Village Apartments. The first Phase will build 44 units that are one bedroom apartments that will house that will serve only veterans. There are 59 veterans with HUD-VASH vouchers that cannot find any affordable one-bedroom apartments. It is well documented that this is due to the less than 1% vacancy rate. Phase I will cost an estimated \$3.5 million, not including the land that ABCCM already owns next to the Veterans Restoration Quarters. We currently have \$1.3 million in pledges and will break ground in the next 60 days. Completion is planned for November 1, 2016. Phase II will begin after ABCCM has another \$3 million in pledges and will add 56 one-bedroom apartments. This will bring the total capacity on completion to 100 units, enough to eliminate those currently waiting.

This will provide 100 affordable housing units, with 44 one bedroom units in Phase I and 56 units with 8 being two bedrooms to bring the total to 100 apartments. This will serve only veterans with half who are below 30% AMI, and half who are below 50% AMI.

These will serve single male veterans, most of whom are disabled on fixed income. They will have to have a HUD-VASH voucher to subsidize their housing. All units will rent for \$723/mo. or less as allowed by HUD-VASH. With 59 who currently are having to stay at the VRQ with no place to go, or those at Homeward Bound who need housing off the streets with no place to go, this will solve a critical problem providing them with permanent supportive housing for the rest of their lives.

## What key steps will you take to achieve the results of this project?\*

ABCCM already has a loan commitment of \$3.5 million from First Citizen's Bank. The business plan demonstrates that low-income rents from the residents with HUD-VASH vouchers that guarantee \$723/mo. will support the debt service while we raise funds and pledges for the project. We currently have \$1.2 million in pledges. We are seeking 10% from the county to support our veterans. Ground-breaking will be by Feb. 1, and the project is scheduled for completion by November, 2016.

ABCCM has completed \$2.5 million in expansion of three Crisis Ministry centers from 2011 to 2014. Private funding from the churches, businesses and individuals raised the funds and all are debt free and paid for. We are grateful to Buncombe County Commissioners for completing the ABCCM Hominy Valley project by pledging and funding the last \$140,000 needed to complete this. We are asking for 10% funding on this project as we already have significant community support at \$4.2 million in pledges. We are confident with your support we will successfully raise the remaining \$1.3 million in pledges.

ABCCM utilized a project management software that successfully tracks and monitors progress. ABCCM's Chief Operating Officer, Mr. Jay Lee, is primarily responsible for all project management and facilities management at ABCCM.

ABCCM has sophisticated technological resources and high speed fiber optics at all of our locations. ERC Broadband provides all the fiber connectivity and houses our servers with triple redundancy at their offices in the Federal Building; Electronic Office provides all maintenance and supportive services for our hardware, software, and networking; Crawley, Lee and Co. provide our Computer System Manager who handles all design, implementation, and backup systems for the Network, Databases, and Communication systems.

ABCCM has invested in the Blackbaud database to integrate finances, grant management, donor and volunteer tracking. We utilize Charity Tracker for our case management and reporting and the NC Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) database. ABCCM has robust tracking and reporting capabilities that are flexible and have powerful analytic capacity.

ABCCM's mission is twofold: to create opportunities for others to serve their neighbors in need; and, to fill gaps in the safety net that provide short-term and long-term solutions to sustain individuals and families. Just as the Veterans Quarters grew out of the 2006-2010 plan; Transformation Village was the next logical step in our 2011-2015 plan. We successfully took 25% of all homeless who were veterans and put together collaborative partnerships that has been recognized as a national best practice. Now that homeless women and families has grown from 10% to 25% of all homeless, we are poised to do it again. Our General Assembly of Churches, with its 277 members, adopted the plan as presented by the Board of Directors at our annual

meeting in November. The Board also approves an annual strategic plan tied to the 5 year plan at the annual meeting. In the last 10 years our operating budget and support grew from \$2.1 million to \$6.5 million. We added 80,000 sq.ft. of facilities.

Veterans Village - Capital

The \$350,000 request is 10% of the capital expenditures for the \$3,500,000 project. A loan through First Citizens Bank will finance the construction of the building on land presently owned by ABCCM. The loan will be repaid over 10+ years with proceeds from rental income derived from the property. Expenditures for the project to date of \$20,000 include a retainer fee for architectural services. Current year organizational budget

represents ABCCM's operations budget. Proposed year budget includes ABCCM operations budget plus the grant from Buncombe County for this project and the cost to complete the capital construction project. A recent one estate gift of \$1.2 million has been received.
