

# Moving Science into the Spotlight


- Science education: Earth, STEM, Life Science Programming



### **Budget Request**

- Capital: \$75,000
  - Final buildout expenses: i.e. flooring, lighting
  - Exhibits: Discovery Museum, Magic Planet, Dinosaur, STEM Lab, and more!
- Operations: \$50,000
  - More staff to accommodate school groups and visitors
  - Increased seminars, outreach, and afterschool programs
  - Expand Programming beyond current earth science to incorporate STEM and life sciences



- Historical Funding from Buncombe County
  - ► In-kind support at Pack Place FY 14/15 \$94,600
  - Buncombe County Service Foundation, STEM Preschool Program FY 14/15 \$16,657
  - Buncombe County Service Foundation, Capital Improvements for AMOS FY 15/16 \$50,000
