


Mission of Buncombe County VTC


- To promote public safety through accountability and responsibility, and

Structure of the Court

 A non-adversarial, team based approach to providing services that includes the Judge, Court Coordinator, Probation, Treatment Staff, Veterans Justice Outreach Specialist, Veterans Services Specialist, Law Enforcement, Community Based Service Providers, & Mentors



Effectiveness of Veterans Treatment Court (VTC)



- 50% decrease in substance use
- 43% reduction in depression symptoms
- 29% decrease in PTSD symptoms
- 31.4% increase in owning or renting one's own apartment or house
- Significant improvements in family functioning, social connectedness, and general physical health
