<b>Background information</b> The approval of the Resolution Supporting Art, History and Culture in Buncombe County led to the formation of a committee to facilitate the creation of a “History Wall” inside the new Courthouse and the creation of a permanent outdoor iconic monument for the Courthouse Plaza. The committee, made up of individuals from the Asheville Art Community, recommends selecting a local graphics designer to use images from Pack Library’s North Carolina collection to create a history wall and selecting a local sculptor or metal worker to design and construct a kinetic sculpture for the Courthouse Plaza. Additionally, a wooden quilt that highlights the history and life in Buncombe County will be installed in the new Courthouse. This original piece of art is being carved and donated by the WNC Carvers Club.
