



#### National Death Rates













## Opioid Prescribing Rates by County








#### **Inmates on Detox Protocol**




#### **EMS Overdose/Poisoning Incidents**




## Opioid Impact on ED and Hospital Usage (National)




 399 babies delivered at Mission Hospital with a positive toxicology
