Background information The DWI Taskforce grant from the NCGHSP has been awarded to Buncombe County as a sub-recipient under the City of Asheville's Police Department Application. The grant provides funding for a six member task force, two of which are Buncombe County Sheriff's Deputy positions. The remaining members of the task force, including one supervisor, are Asheville Police Officers. The grant initially paid 100% of the salary, benefits, equipment, vehicles and training for the taskforce positions. This fourth year of funding requires a 50% match for the salary and benefit costs of the two County positions only.
