#### Duties


- Research/investigate issues impacting homelessness

Inclusive membership jointly appointed by Asheville City Council and Buncombe County Commission


# History

- 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness adopted in 2005, now expired
  - Led to increase in permanent housing and services for homeless families and individuals
  - Focused attention on chronically homeless individuals
- Since 2006, more than 1,700 homeless people have been housed as a result of efforts guided by the 10 Year Plan
- Development and implementation of system-wide strategies

## **Development of Strategic Plan**

- Created in collaboration with Homeless Coalition
- Incorporated subcommittee and workgroup recommendations
- Survey of individuals experiencing homelessness conducted in partnership with UNCA's Health and Wellness department
- Used Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and Housing Inventory Count (HIC) data
- Addressed HUD guidance
- Multiple planning sessions conducted in HIAC
