- WHEREAS, Ralph Lewis was born on April 25, 1928 in Madison County and raised in a musical family where he picked up mandolin and guitar at an early age and began travelling with his brother playing music; and
- WHEREAS, Ralph Lewis was not born in Asheville but settled here after his military service and started the Lewis Refrigeration Company based in Candler; and
- WHEREAS, Ralph Lewis lead his own band before serving in the US Navy; later he became one of the Blue Grass Boys touring Europe, Japan and the US and appearing regularly on the Grand Ole Opry; and
- WHEREAS, in his later years and up until his death, Ralph Lewis was one of the Sons of Ralph playing with his sons Marty and Don; and
- WHEREAS, Ralph Lewis passed away on August 5, 2017 at the age of 89 leaving family and friends and a bluegrass legacy that will never be forgotten; and
- WHEREAS, it has been said that Ralph Lewis was "adept at both the high lonesome sound of bluegrass and the rhythms of rock and roll and that his music sounded as if it were carved out of the mountains themselves" and this Board wishes to honor the memory of Ralph Lewis and his legendary musical career.
