Introduction

The Buncombe County Commissioners have identified affordable housing as a priority. Affordable housing opportunities for all segments of the community are recognized as an important part of developing and maintaining a healthy economy and workforce.

The County has established the following goals for the Affordable Housing Services Program (AHSP):

- ✓ Increase the stock of affordable housing
- ✓ Preserve existing housing stock
- ✓ Reduce substandard housing
- ✓ Support homeownership initiatives such as downpayment assistance programs

Through the AHSP, the County is offering several programs to promote these goals. Three Two of these programs are offered **year-round**, including the Permit Fee Rebate Program and the Employee Housing Assistance Program.

- Permit Fee Rebate Program
- Development Incentive Program (new for FY2013)
- Employee Housing Assistance Program

This application is for the Permit Fee Rebate Program.

In addition, the County administers a low interest loan program-fourth program, which offers low-interest loans to assist in the provision of decent, safe, and affordable housing. Applications for this program are accepted once a year. 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Program Description Permit Fee Rebate Program

Overview

Buncombe County offers a permit fee rebate on building, well and septic permits for housing that is constructed and sold or rented affordably.

One-half of the permit fees paid for the construction of housing that meets state building code and that costs less than \$224,000, 155,000 for up to a two-bedroom unit, and less than \$175,000 for a three-or more bedroom unit, can be returned as an incentive to build affordable housing.

MSD and the Water Authority have also agreed to rebate a portion of their fees to the applicant, if the County agrees that the home meets affordability standards. Save the receipts for your permits from these agencies as these could potentially result in a partial rebate, as well. These agencies should be contacted directly if you intend to apply for the additional rebates.

Eligibility

Both rental development and housing for sale could be eligible. The following projects qualify as affordable:

- Rental Housing- housing that is developed with assistance from a state or federal
 program requiring it to remain affordable for tenants below 80% of Area Median Income
 (AMI). If a project is not assisted with state or federal funds, and therefore is not bound to
 an affordability period, then deed restrictions must be imposed to keep property
 affordable for at least five (5) years.
- Housing for sale- single family or condominium-type units that meet state building code
 (excludes mobile homes) and are sold for \$224155,000 or less for houses up to and
 including 2 bedrooms, and for \$175,000 or less for three or more bedrooms, or are
 assessed by Buncombe County at less than those amounts.

How to Obtain the Rebate

- Pay the regular fees at the start of the project. Keep the receipts.
- When the project is complete, complete the attached Permit Fee Rebate application (extra copies available from the County's Building Permits and Inspections Department or Planning Department).
- Mail the application, the receipts, and evidence of affordability (HUD-1 settlement statement or evidence of federal/state assistance) to:
