### Thomas W. Simpson Administration Building: Facility Condition Assessment

Current Replacement Value: \$4,112,250

Constructed in 1971, Simpson is a two story administration building with basement on the Asheville campus. The building is steel and masonry construction with steel and concrete floor structure and a new membrane roof (2017-2018 project). The envelope of the building is a mix of precast concrete and fluted block veneer.






