### **GE Expansion Overview**

- As announced on March 1<sup>st</sup>, GE is seeking to expand its existing manufacturing facility.
- Investment in new machinery and equipment for related growth and legacy platforms.
- GE commits to create and maintain for a 10 year period the following:
  - \$104,864,100 in capital investment
  - 131 new full-time jobs
  - \$49,000 average annual wage
