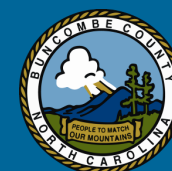

CLINICAL SERVICES (828) 250-5000

IMMUNIZATIONS & TB SKIN TEST (828) 250-5096

Immunizations:

- For children and adults
- No appointment needed

Travel Vaccines:

- By appointment only
- Call 4-6 weeks before you travel

TB Skin Test:

- TB Skin Test - self pay or covered by some insurance plans
- TB Skin testing is offered Monday, Tuesday and Friday, ONLY. Walk-in basis (first come, first served)
- Clients need to return three days after test for results.

STD CLINIC (828) 250-5109

- Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) testing and treatment
- HIV testing and counseling; referral for treatment
- Condoms
- There is no charge

BREAST & CERVICAL CANCER CONTROL PROGRAM (BCCCP) (828) 250-6006

Provides free services for women and transgender people who qualify. Clients must be seen by this program before a cancer diagnosis is made to qualify.

- Cervical Cancer testing & HPV (Pap tests)
- Breast exams & mammograms
- Blood pressure & cholesterol screening
- Referrals for care as needed

FAMILY PLANNING (828) 250-5000

- Pregnancy testing
- Cervical cancer testing (PAP & HPV tests)
- Physical exam
- Birth control, condoms
- Emergency contraception (pill or IUD)
- Infertility counseling
- STD/HIV testing, treatment or referral

DISEASE CONTROL (828) 250-5109

Public health nurses work with medical providers and other agencies throughout the county to control communicable infectious diseases. They also teach the public what they need to know to prevent or stop the spread of diseases.

- TB (tuberculosis) program
- Communicable Disease Program

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH (828) 250-5016

Services include:

- Permitting & inspection of new well and septic tank systems; restaurants and tattoo parlors; and swimming pools
- Childhood lead poisoning prevention and investigation

NUTRITION WIC (828) 250-5000

WIC or Women, Infant and Children program helps provide pregnant women and women with children up to the age of 5 with:

- Healthy food education
- WIC services & food vouchers
- Breastfeeding education and support
