## **Proclamation**

of

## Arson Awareness Week

WHEREAS,	the US Fire Administration reports that there are an estimated 210,300 intentionally set fires each year resulting in approximately 375 deaths and 1,300 injuries across the United States; and
WHEREAS,	in Buncombe County in 2010 there were 25 set fires that resulted in losses in excess of \$1 million; and
WHEREAS,	public awareness is a great deterrent to arson bringing attention to the seriousness of the crime and its effects on a community; and
WHEREAS,	local arson investigation by fire professionals in Buncombe County and the City of Asheville has resulted in 8 arrests in 2010; and
WHEREAS,	arson can devastate a community and cause the decline of a neighbourhood through increased insurance premiums, loss of business revenue, and a decrease in property values; and
WHEREAS,	citizens can reduce the likelihood of arson by reporting unusual activities along with implementing improved internal and external security for homes and businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That the week of May 1 - 7, 2011 be proclaimed:

## **ARSON AWARENESS WEEK**

in Buncombe County.

- 2. That this Board does hereby commend local fire professionals and law enforcement for their work to investigate the crime of arson and to educate the public on the effects and prevention of this crime.
- 3. That this Board requests all citizens to report any suspicious activity to a law enforcement professional and to become acquainted with the signs and seriousness of arson.
