WHEREAS,	the Buncombe County Commissioners and the Buncombe County Sheriff wish to honor Mr. Fisher for his service to the County as a law enforcement officer by awarding him his badge and the service firearm that he carried at the time of his retirement, a Glock Model 26, serial number GAA 902; and

and her o	the Wayne Fisher's badge and a Glock Model 26, Serial No. GAA 902 are declared surplus upon securing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. §14-402 et al., that the County Manager or designee is authorized to award his badge and transfer said firearm to Wayne Fisher in rdance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. § 20-187.2.
