upon se designe	Mike Davis' badge and a Glock Model 17, Serial No. EST 851 are declared surplus and curing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. §14-402 et al., that the County Manager or her is authorized to award his badge and transfer said firearm to Mike Davis in accordance provisions of N.C.G.S. § 20-187.2.
