Re: Letter of Understanding-City of Asheville 4th of July Fireworks 2012-Fire Inspection Responsibilities County Property

Dear Mr. Creighton,

I am writing to confirm our mutual understanding in regards to the City's responsibility for the provision of fire inspection services related to the Fireworks activities/discharge which will be conducted by the City on July 4, 2012 on County owned property located at 164 College St. (the parking deck). The City's Fire Department will:

- 1.) Review the technical and safety aspects of the pyrotechnic display permit.
- 2.) Conduct the required inspections. This includes pre-display set up, display firing and post-display inspections based upon the NCDOI/OSFM (AHJ) Pre-Display and Fireworks Display Checklist, and NFPA 1123 standards.
- 3.) Provision of these City Fire Services on County property will be for this one event only. It is understood and agreed by all parties, that this agreement for the firework display in no way alters the longstanding Inter-local Agreement between the City and County regarding fire code enforcement services.

Specifically, other than in this one instance, the City and County will each continue to be responsible for providing fire code enforcement for their own respective properties as provided in the Inter-local Agreement.

Per you request, I am providing the height and weight specifications of the vehicle to be used to conduct the show. However, please note, that if the truck being on the top deck is problematic we can make the necessary adjustments.

Height/Weight of vehicles

Zambelli says it'll be either a 10' or 16' box truck. Specs are below:

10' 10' long + cab 9' clearance height 8,600 Gross Vehicle Weight + 3,100 payload (max) = 11,700 max total weight

16' 16' long + cab 11' 6'' clearance height 11,500 GVW + 3,400 payload (max) = 14,900 max total weight
