

Resolution Dedicating the Health & Human Service Building at 40 Coxe Avenue in Honor of Margaret Hall Coman

WHEREAS, Margaret Hall Coman began her career with the Buncombe County Department of Public Welfare in 1940 as a caseworker, was promoted to supervisor in 1945, acting superintendent in 1946 and then appointed as the Director of the Department in 1961; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Hall Coman served as Director until 1983 when she retired with a 43 year career in public service; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Hall Coman was a dedicated, talented and loyal servant who treated everyone with respect and dignity throughout her entire career; and

WHEREAS, the building owned by the County at 40 Coxe Avenue has undergone extensive renovation in order to adequately house the County' Health and Human Service functions under one roof; and

WHEREAS, this Board feels that it would be appropriate and fitting to dedicate the home of the Department of Health and Human Services at 40 Coxe Avenue in honor of Margaret Hall Coman.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That the County's building located at 40 Coxe Avenue, housing the Department of Health and Human Services be and it is hereby dedicated in honor of Margaret Hall Coman and that a plaque reflecting this honor be installed at this location.
2. That this resolution be effective upon its adoption.
