WHEREAS,

the Zoning Administrator for Buncombe County has received an application from Jeanette C. Bowling requesting an amendment to The Zoning Map on the parcel identified as follows:

A 0.40 acre portion of PIN 9689-38-1040, located at 300 Bowling Country Road, which is currently zoned Low-Density Residential District R-LD. The Applicant is requesting that the zoning designation be changed from Low-Density Residential District R-LD to Single Family Residential District R-1; and

WHEREAS,

the Zoning Administrator certified that notices of the meeting of the Buncombe County Planning Board at which this application was considered have been properly mailed to members of the Planning Board, the applicant(s), owner(s), and all adjoining property owners at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting; public notice of the meeting has been properly published in a newspaper having general circulation in the County; and notice of the public hearing concerning this zoning map amendment has been prominently posted as required; and

WHEREAS,

pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §153A-344 and §78-719 of the Buncombe County Code of Ordinances, the Planning Board is charged with making a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners and to comment on whether the requested zoning change is consistent or inconsistent with the Comprehensive Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS,

the Planning Board has reviewed the application, has heard public comment, and consulted with planning staff, and, after careful review, has determined that it is in order to approve this application and make recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for Buncombe County that the application be approved.

Based on the facts as set forth above the Buncombe County Planning Board hereby finds and concludes as follows pertaining to the proposed amendment to the Zoning Map as set forth in the said application of Jeanette C. Bowling:

- 1. said zoning change is consistent with the Buncombe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan and Updates as the 2006 Buncombe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan Update described the R-LD district as "primarily intended to provide locations for low density residential and related type development in areas where topographic or other constraints preclude intense urban development" (VII-3);
- 2. the portion of the property the applicant has requested to be rezoned is not an environmentally sensitive area or one that would preclude its inclusion into the Bee Tree Forest Subdivision;

- 3. that the requested map amendment not be detrimental to the owner, adjacent neighbors, or the existing subdivision; and
- 4. therefore said zoning change is reasonable and is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that upon motion and second, the Buncombe County Planning Board hereby recommends as follows:

1. That the Board of Commissioners approve this application for a zoning change for PIN 9689-38-1040 from Low-Density Residential District R-LD to Single Family Residential District R-1.
