RESOLUTION AWARDING A SERVICE FIREARM TO A RETIRING DEPUTY OF THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

- WHEREAS, in accordance with North Carolina General Statute Section 20-187.2, the local body of a law enforcement agency shall award a retiring deputy his or her badge and may, in its discretion, award the deputy's service firearm; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Buncombe provides the service firearm of a deputy who retires through the North Carolina Local Government Retirement System with ten (10) or more years of service to Buncombe County as a deputy sheriff or who retires due to medical disability; and
- WHEREAS, Billy Anders has passed away after a short illness, after rendering honorable and invaluable service to the County of Buncombe. Billy was sworn in as a reserve Buncombe County Deputy January 30th, 2003 as he worked full time in area law enforcement agencies. Billy became a full time Buncombe County Deputy Feb. 8, 2010; and
- WHEREAS, the Buncombe County Commissioners and the Buncombe County Sheriff wish to honor Mr. Anders for his service to the County as a law enforcement officer by awarding his brother, Deputy Bobby Anders, Billy's badge and the service firearm that Billy carried at the time of his death, a Glock Model 17, Serial No.TBN 937; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That Billy Anders' badge and a Glock Model 17, Serial No. TBN 937 are declared surplus and that the Sheriff is authorized to award his badge and transfer said firearm to Bobby Anders in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. § 20-187.2.
2. That this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
