PUBLIC HEARINGS

Plasticard-Locktech international Revenue Bonds

Mike Frue, Senior Staff Attorney, explained that pursuant to Chapter 159C of the General Statutes of North Carolina the Buncombe County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority intended to file an application with the Secretary of the Department of Commerce for approval of an industrial and manufacturing project for Plasticard-Locktech International, LLP, a North Carolina limited liability partnership consisting of the acquisition and installation of new machinery and equipment to be located at 605 Sweeten Creek Industrial Park to be used for the manufacturing of magnetic strip cards for the hotel key, gift card and/or other types of. All or a portion of the cost of the project will be financed by the issuance of not exceeding \$4,250,000 aggregate principal amount of qualified small issue industrial revenue bonds. Mr. Frue recommended approval of the project.

Commissioner Belcher emphasized that there was no obligation created for the County as a part of the issuance of these bonds.

The Chairman opened the public hearing at 6:50 p.m.

Commissioner Belcher moved to approve the resolution regarding the revenue bonds. Vice Chair Frost seconded and the motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Newman nominated himself and Commissioner Frost to serve on the **Metropolitan Planning Organization Board**; Commissioner Belcher nominated Commissioner Newman and Commissioner Fryar to serve. After a poll of the Board, **Commissioners Newman and Frost** were appointed to the **Transportation Advisory Committee**.

Commissioner Fryar nominated Vice Chair Belcher to serve on the Tourism Development Authority. The motion passed 7-0.

Vice Chair Belcher nominated **Commissioner Frost** to continue serving on the **Crimestoppers Board of Directors**. The motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Frost nominated **Commissioner Jones** to continue serving on the **Juvenile Crime Prevention Council**. The motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Jones nominated **Commissioner DeBruhl** to serve on the **Health and Human Services Board**. The motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Frost nominated **Commissioner Newman** to serve on the **Riverfront Development Board**. The motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Newman nominated **Commissioner DeBruhl** to serve on the Land of Sky Regional Council. The motion passed 7-0.
