



63.8% of K-12 enrolled children in Barnardsville school districts received free or reduced lunch in FY2016.



## Educational Attainment:




## Food and Medical Assistance:



433 Barnardsville residents received Food Assistance and 623 received Medicaid benefits at the end of Fiscal Year 2016.





# Economic Impact: Barnardsville, NC



The population growth for Barnardsville has been more variable than both Buncombe County and North Carolina. Median Household income for Barnardsville is \$32,175, lower than North Carolina's Median Household income of \$46,868.
