



42.5% of K-12 enrolled children in Weaverville school districts received free or reduced lunch in FY2016.


Educational Attainment:






2,238 Weaverville Residents received Food Assistance and 3,414 received Medicaid benefits at the end of Fiscal Year 2016.







The population growth for Weaverville has been more variable than both Buncombe County and North Carolina.







Median Household income for Weaverville is \$49,621, higher than North Carolina's Median Household income of \$46,868.
