3 things you can do now

1. Register

- Fill out a registration form.
- Send it in by Friday, Oct. 9.
- Please register early. If you do miss the deadline you can register and vote at any early voting location Oct. 15-31.

2. Check Your Sample Ballot

- Look up your voter information.
- Find your sample ballot for a list of what you will be voting on.
- Do your research before heading to the polls so you will be ready to cast your vote when you get there.

3. Choose Your Voting Method

- Review the three ways to vote.
- Choose what works best for you.
- Vote!

3 ways to vote

1. Absentee By-Mail

- Anyone can vote absentee by-mail.
- Fill out a request form by Oct. 27.
- Watch for your ballot in the mail. Follow the instructions and either mail it back or drop it off in person at our office or any early voting location.

2. Early Voting

- Oct. 15-31
- Vote at any of the 16 early voting locations.
- Use the wait map on our website to see how many voters are in line.

3. Election Day

- Nov. 3
- Polls are open 6:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.
- Find your assigned polling location under Voter Information on our website or, as always, call or visit our office for help.
