BUNCOMBE COUNTY OUT OF PRECINCT VOTING LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 163-128 provides that upon a resolution adopted by the county board of elections and approved by the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections voters from a given precinct may be temporarily transferred, for the purpose of voting, to an adjacent precinct; and,

WHEREAS, any such transfers shall be for the period of time equal only to the term of office of the county board of elections making such transfer.
