Dear Candidate:

As campaign time approaches, the Town of Weaverville would like to take this opportunity to inform and remind political candidates about the Town of Weaverville Sign Ordinance governing the placement of political signage within the **Town limits and the one-mile Extraterritorial Zoning Jurisdiction**. Section 36-201(2) of the Weaverville Zoning Ordinance states the following:

(2) Political signs shall be considered temporary signs, and shall met the following requirements:

(a) No political sign shall be placed in any Town or State public right-of-way which includes utility poles and/or street medians;
(Political signs may be placed on private property with the property owner's permission without permit or permit fee.)

(b) All such signs shall be removed within two (2) days after the election.

In addition to all above requirements, political signs that are placed on private property must meet the general sign requirements of the Weaverville Zoning Ordinance. For you review, I am enclosing a copy of the Weaverville Sign Ordinance, the map of the zoning district. **Political signs in violation will be removed.**

ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTION 36-201. Temporary Signs.

(2) Political signs shall be considered temporary signs, and shall meet the following requirements:

- a. No political sign shall be placed in any Town or State public Right-of-way which includes utility poles and/or street medians. (Political signs may be placed on private property with the property owner's permission without permit or permit fee.)**
- b. All such signs shall be removed within two (2) days after the election day.**
