***Triple P Intervention Key**

Level 2 Seminar (L2 Sem): Large-group, 90-minute presentation of general positive parenting strategies

Level 3 Primary Care (L3 PC): Four sessions with a parent focused on a particular behavior concern

Level 3 Discussion Groups (L3 DG): One 2-hour small group presentation/discussion going deep into one particular behavior concern

Level 4 Standard (L4 St): Ten 1-hour sessions with a parent of a child with moderate to severe behavior concerns

Level 4 Group (L4 Gr): The closest to a “parenting class” in Triple P. Eight in-depth sessions (5 face-to-face; 3 phone follow-ups) with parents of a child with moderate to severe behavior concerns OR parents with few parenting resources or role models
