Instructions for Registering a Home Birth

The process to register a Home Birth in Buncombe County is listed below.

1. Fill out a Home Birth Registration Form (available on the website or by calling 250-5214 or 250-5213)
2. Obtain a statement from someone that can verify that the mother was pregnant (this can be a co-worker, Pastor, neighbor, friend or anyone that is not a relative), this document must be notarized. You are welcome to use this form: [Affidavit of Pregnancy.pdf](#)

3. Obtain a document that verifies your residence (utility bill, tax record, etc.).

****This document is required.**

4. Send the Home Birth Registration Form to us;

5. You will receive a call from our office to make an appointment to come in and complete the registration of your home birth. The Mother may not be the only person required to be present, the Father may also be required depending on individual circumstances.
