

### **Benchmark Analysis**

#### Overview

- ETC Institute's DirectionFinder® program was originally developed in 1999 to help community leaders across the United States use statistically valid community survey data as a tool for making better decisions. Since November of 1999, the survey has been administered in more than 500 communities in 50 states. Most participating communities conduct the survey on an annual or biennial basis.
- This report contains benchmarking data from two sources: (1) a
  national survey that was administered by ETC Institute during the
  summer of 2021 to a random sample of more than 5,000 residents
  across the United States, and (2) a regional survey administered
  during the summer of 2021 to a random sample of over 400
  residents in the Atlantic Region of the United States.


#### **Interpreting the Tables**

- These averages are based on the results of the 2021 survey that was administered by ETC institute. Benchmark results for Buncombe County are on the following pages.



## **Perceptions of the City/County**


by the sum percentage of respondents that gave a rating of *excellent* or *good* (excluding *don't know* responses)




# Level of Satisfaction with Core City/County Services




## Level of Satisfaction with City/County Communication
