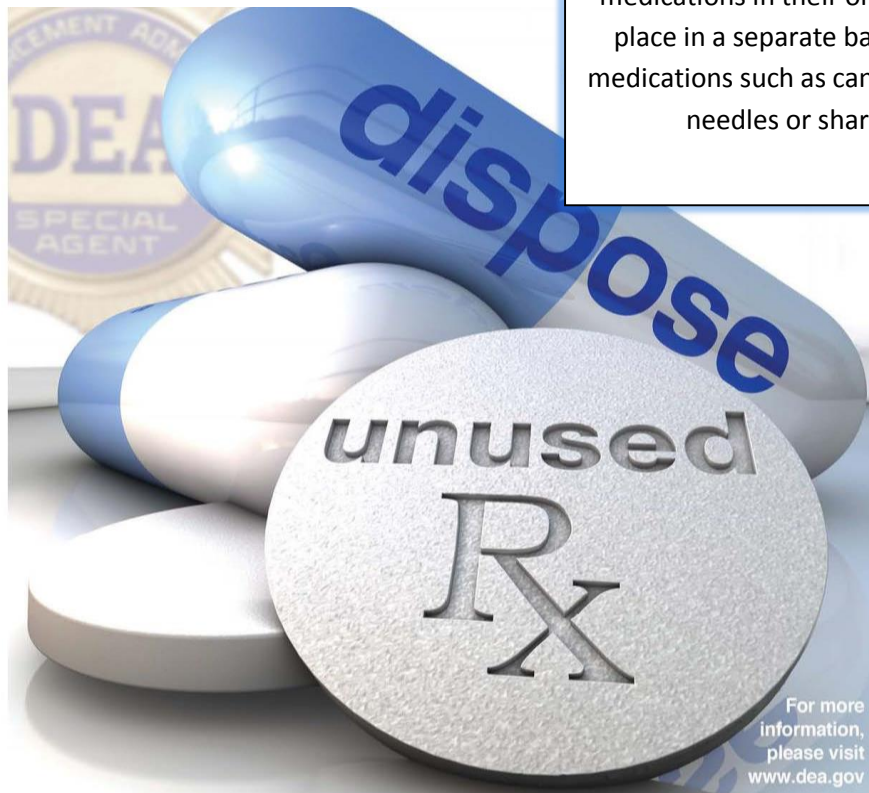
Bring unneeded medications to a location in Buncombe County listed here:

Empty dry pill medications into a bag; leave liquid medications in their original container and place in a separate bag. NO Radioactive medications such as cancer medications. NO needles or sharps accepted.
