The Buncombe SWCD will be selling #1 Fraser Fir Christmas Trees again this year. The 6 and 7 foot trees are locally grown and harvested a day or so before the sale to insure maximum freshness and longevity. They will be sold at a cost of \$32 each, and all you have to do to get one is call the SWCD office to reserve it, send us your payment, and then come by the office on the sale days and pick it up.



You may call the District anytime between now and November 18th to buy a tree. The dates and times of the sale are November 23rd from 3 to 7 p.m. and November 24th from 12 to 7 p.m. The sale location is 49 Mount Carmel Road in the Erwin Hills community. Proceeds from the sale will be used to benefit our environmental education programs, so buy a tree and help our environment too!!

2015 FALL ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION FIELD DAYS

The District held it's fall Environmental Education Field Days on September 29th, and October 1st, 2015. Approximately 450 students from Hominy Valley, North Windy Ridge, Haw Creek, and Sand Hill Venable schools attended the events. Stations included pollinators, reptile ecology, stream ecology, the water cycle, wildlife, soils, waste reduction, agriculture, and natural science. The event was scheduled to be held on the farm at Warren Wilson College but after weeks of very dry weather, heavy rains made it necessary to move the event inside and **Crossroads Assembly Church** in West Asheville agreed to be the host site. The students had a great time learning about all the different aspects of the natural environment.


It's Contest Time!!!

SEEDLING SALE REMINDER

The District will be having it annual tree seedling sale the first week of

March 2016. We will be sending out more information prior to the sale. In addition to white pine seedlings we will be selling Black Cherry, Black Walnut, Butternut, Persimmon, River Birch, Southern Crabapple, Crape Myrtle, and White Oak.

Hardwood seedlings will be sold for 1 dollar each and White Pine will be sold for **25 cents each**. March is a ideal time to plant bare root seedlings, so plan ahead and come out to our seedling sale! Look for more information in our February 2016 newsletter and on the County website.
