



NCDOT Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program

Overview

- As a recipient of federal and state funds through the NCDOT - Public Transportation Division, Buncombe County is required to use its best efforts to identify and use disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs) in procurements and contracts associated with Buncombe County's Community Transportation Program, Mountain Mobility.
- DBE firms must be certified by the NCDOT Office of Contractual Services.

Benefits of NCDOT-Certification

- Provides opportunities to participate in the performance of contracts financed in whole or in part with state and/or federal funds.
- Provides technical assistance to certified firms.
- Firms have been pre-qualified to work on NCDOT contracts.

NCDOT Directory of Transportation Firms

- Firms are listed in the NCDOT Directory of Transportation Firms, a consolidated list of firms which have been certified through North Carolina's Unified Certification Program as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE), Small Professional Services Firm (SPSF), Minority Business Enterprise (MBE), Woman Business Enterprise (WBE) and/or Small Business Enterprise (SBE).

Application Process

- Firms must complete an application and must submit other required documents to support eligibility of the firm as a DBE.
- Site visits are scheduled with the applicant.
- An annual affidavit is required to maintain certification.
