I am writing this letter to communicate the unanimous request of the Board of Aldermen that the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) turn over ownership of the following road to the Town of Woodfin:


Barton Road (alternately known as State Road 2092).

This request was passed unanimously by the Board of Aldermen at their December 15, 2009 meeting.

At this same meeting the Board of Aldermen requested that the NCDOT review the condition of Baird Cove Lane (alternately known as State Road 2091) as it appears this road in particular would profit from paving and stormwater control measures. The Board of Aldermen have not requested ownership of Baird Cove Lane at this time due to the fact that the majority of this road is outside the corporate limits of the Town of Woodfin.
