In our first two years **1,017** Integrated Intakes were provided at the FJC.

In FY18 **61%** accessed more than one provider on their first visit to the FJC.




- 83% identified domestic violence as the primary victimization
- 13% identified sexual assault or stalking as the primary victimization

## **Increasing Victim Safety**

### In FY18:


- 97% of survey respondents had a plan to keep themselves safe and they knew what to do if they were in danger after FJC Intake.
- **85%** of survey respondents reported ( decreased fear and anxiety level.
