RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO DONATE SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY

Stat. § 160A-280, a county may transfer to a nonprofit organization incorporated by one of the United States any personal property or equipment that the governing board determines to be surplus, obsolete or unused; WHEREAS, a request has been received from French Broad Volunteer Fire & Rescue, Inc., a North Carolina non-profit corporation organized and doing business in the State of North Carolina, ("French Broad Fire") for the donation of a surplus vehicle; WHEREAS, the County has one surplus 2008 Ford Explorer, VIN#: 1FMEU73808UA90710 and identified as County vehicle #1978, which this Board believes the donation of the surplus vehicle will aid French Broad Fire in its work for the community; WHEREAS, public notice of Board's intent to transfer said surplus personal property to French Broad Fire has been made at least five (5) days prior to the adoption of this resolution; and this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of WHEREAS, the County that this resolution be adopted. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows: 1. That said 2008 Ford Explorer is hereby declared surplus property. 2. The Finance Director and Procurement Manager, or either of them, is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to transfer this vehicle to French Broad Fire. 3.
