

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO DONATE SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. 153A-176 and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-280, a county may transfer to a nonprofit organization incorporated by one of the United States any personal property or equipment that the governing board determines to be surplus, obsolete or unused;

WHEREAS, a request has been received from W4H Asheville, a North Carolina non-profit corporation organized and doing business in the State of North Carolina d/b/a Working Wheels ("Working Wheels") for the donation of five (5) surplus vehicles;

WHEREAS, the County has the following surplus vehicles which this Board believes will aid Working Wheels in its work for the community;

WHEREAS, public notice of Board's intent to transfer said surplus personal property to Working Wheels has been made at least five (5) days prior to the adoption of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the County that this resolution be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That the vehicles identified above are hereby declared surplus property.
2. The Finance Director and Procurement Manager, or either of them, is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to transfer these vehicles to Working Wheels.
3. That this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
