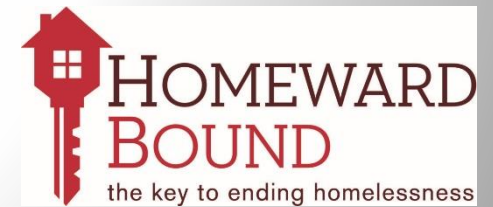
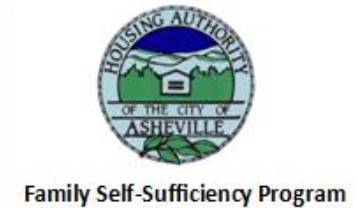

Why?

A dependable vehicle enables program participants to make improvements in their lives:

- 56% report an improvement in housing situation
- 74% report an increase in income
- 88% report an improvement in quality of life
