## RESOLUTION AWARDING A SERVICE FIREARM TO A RETIRING DEPUTY OF THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

- WHEREAS, in accordance with North Carolina General Statute Section 20-187.2, the local body of a law enforcement agency shall award a retiring deputy his or her badge and may, in its discretion, award the deputy's service firearm; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Buncombe provides the service firearm of a deputy who retires through the North Carolina Local Government Retirement System with ten (10) or more years of service to Buncombe County as a deputy sheriff or who retires due to medical disability; and
- WHEREAS, Isaac McLemore has retired after rendering honorable and invaluable service to the County of Buncombe and its citizens from April 16, 2007 through June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 as a full time sworn deputy.
- WHEREAS, the Buncombe County Commissioners and the Buncombe County Sheriff wish to honor
  Mr. McLemore for his service to the County as a law enforcement officer by awarding
  him his badge and the service firearm that he carried at the time of his retirement, a
  Glock Model 17, serial number BEPW 890; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

That Isaac McLemore's badge and a Glock Model 17, Serial No. BEPW 890 are declared surplus and that the County Manager or her designee is authorized to award his badge and transfer said firearm to Isaac McLemore in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. § 20-187.2.
