Background and Request

Background:

- Announced January 31st, Nypro has chosen Buncombe County for its expansion.
- Existing employer with 325 employees and two prior expansions in Buncombe County (2010, 2011)
- Manufacturer of medical devices (e.g., casings for medicines) using injection molding with plastics

Request:

- Board of Commissioners approval for:
 - Economic Development Incentives for Nypro; and
 - Economic Development Agreement between Nypro and Buncombe County.



Investment and Job Schedule

- As part of its facility expansion project, Nypro will:
 - Create 68 new jobs;
 - Invest \$18.4 million in real and business personal property (add 16K sqft); and
 - Provide an average wage of \$21.94 hour including at least half of employee health insurance costs.
 - Meet performance commitments within 3 years.

Proposed Incentive

- Joint economic development effort between the Department of Commerce, A-B Tech, Economic Development Coalition (EDC), and Buncombe County.
- Per Buncombe County's Economic Development Incentive Policy, and pending Commissioner approval, Buncombe County commits to a total incentive of \$170,000.

Economic Development Impact

- Creation of 68 jobs and \$18.4M in investment.
- Generation of approximately \$680K in ad valorem tax revenue over 10 years (net positive revenue impact of approximately \$500K).
- Labor impact of ~\$8.7M (see EDC Economic Impact Analysis below).

Job Incentive and Average Wage

- Based on Nypro's job creation plans, **35 out of the 68 proposed jobs qualify for the jobs incentive** in the Buncombe County Economic Development Incentive Policy (greater than \$20.90 per hour, or \$43,472 per year).
- All 68 jobs exceed the 2019 "living wage" published by Just Economics (greater than \$13.65 per hour, or \$28,392 per year) for a full-time living-wage employee without health insurance.
- Additionally, all 68 jobs will receive at least 50% subsidy of employee benefits.

Notes
