

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING DEPUTY FINANCE OFFICERS

- WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statutes §159-24 specifies and directs that each local government shall appoint a Finance Officer to hold office and carry out the duties prescribed by law;
- WHEREAS, there will be occasions when the Buncombe County Finance Officer is unable to be present in order to approve certain actions or sign preaudit certificates;
- WHEREAS, in the event a Local State of Emergency is declared by the Board of Commissioners or its Chair as authorized by state law and County ordinance it may be impossible to predict which members of appropriate Finance staff will be present and available; and
- WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that certain members of Finance staff possesses the requisite knowledge, experience and qualifications to serve as Deputy Finance Director for Buncombe County by reason of position and job description.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That in the event a Local State of Emergency is declared the individual County employees holding the listed positions shall serve as a Deputy Finance Officer with full power and authority to act in the place and stead of the Buncombe County Finance Officer.

2. That appointment as a Deputy Finance Officer as provided herein shall commence upon the Declaration of Local State of Emergency and shall remain in effect until said Declaration expires or is rescinded.
3. That this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
