## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE AND THE COUNTY OF BUNCOMBE REGARDING EMPLOYEE REDEPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared by the City, the County, and the State of North Carolina due to the COVID-19 Pandemic;

WHEREAS, Buncombe County requested the City of Asheville provide City employees serve in Buncombe County positions to support Buncombe County continuity of operations during the COVID-19 State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, The City of Asheville seeks to support Buncombe County requests and redeploy City of Asheville employees to serve in Buncombe County positions, when appropriate to support Buncombe County's service delivery during the COVID-19 State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, The City of Asheville may request Buncombe County employees serve in City of Asheville positions to support City of Asheville continuity of operations during the COVID-19 State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, the Parties are authorized to execute and enter into this Interlocal Agreement pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-461; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners feels that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of Buncombe County to enter into this Interlocal Agreement with the City of Asheville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF BUNCOMBE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the County Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement for the purpose of providing City of Asheville employees to perform Buncombe County job functions to support Buncombe County continuity of operations during the COVID-19 State of Emergency, and request Buncombe County provide employees to perform City of Asheville job functions to support City of Asheville continuity of operations during the COVID-19 State of Emergency.

2.	That this Resolution shall be effective retroactive to the execution of the County
	of Buncombe and the City of Asheville Declaration of Local State of Emergency
	dated March 12, 2020.
